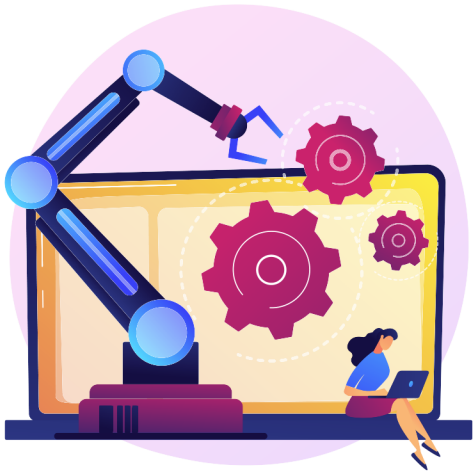




Challenged by Technology Adoption?
